Overview		6 young people took part in a group discussion facilitated by Connexions.
2 – Safety, security, environment and planning	Yes – 4 Not Sure/ Partly – 2	<p>In this group of 6, 4 agreed with the views and 2 were unsure or only partly agreed. Generally thye group felt in the light of the Partnership findings there was nothing wrong with going to the next stage and checking out findings.</p> <p>While there was a majority agreement there were concerns: "They are not fortune tellers and they can't be sure what will happen in the future."</p>
3 – Impacts	Yes – 5 Not Sure/ Partly – 1	<p>5 young people agreed with the Partnership views and 1 was not sure or only partly agreed.</p> <p>Generally the group view was "We want to be clear what we are getting out of it before we know that the positives outweigh the negatives so we should go to the next phase. We need to keep in the process until we know more about it."</p> <p>In particular there was support for the jobs it was felt the development would bring and this brought support to continue to the next stage.</p>
4 – Community benefits	Yes – 5 Not Sure/ Partly – 1	<p>5 young people agreed and c1 was not sure or only partly agreed.</p> <p>If Sweden had 130 million for their facility in Community Benefits package how much would this work out at per haed in West Cumbria?</p> <p>The group accepted the view that it was too far in advance to be specific but equally wanted to be clear soon on "How much will we get to have it here?"</p>
8 – Overall views on participation		<p>All 6 young people felt progression to the next stage was reasonable.</p> <p>"We should go further, there is no harm in going further. We are not making the real decision now. We need to go further and get all the info."</p> <p>2 young people particularly raised "How much will it cost? Will there be any profit? Will we lose out on the</p>

		cost of it? Further research needs to be done on this and on finding a site it will be safe on."
